5. In general, for-profit corporations are NOT eligible for Associate Membership

2. TABS reserves the right to revoke Associate Membership if TABS, in its sole judgment, deems the Associate Member's business practices or communications to be inconsistent with TABS' organizational values and/or member interests.
3. Associate Membership does not constitute TABS' endorsement of any individual, organization or service, and Associate Members will not allege or imply such endorsement in their print, electronic or oral communications.
4. The Associate Member will not use the TABS word-mark, visual identity, or logo in any form, except for TABS' official "Proud Associate Member" web badge logo.
5. Associate Membership is annual and renewable, subject to the foregoing provisions. The benefit period runs from July 1 to June 30 annually.
